Admissions Policy

For the September 2020 intake

Person Responsible: Trustees of Boughton Primary School

Boughton Primary School is an Academy situated three miles north of Northampton and within the County of Northamptonshire. The Academy Trust is the admission authority and has responsibility for setting the Admission Policy. Northamptonshire County Council manage the admissions and waiting lists for the school.

Places will be allocated to pupils who have an EHC plan that names the school as appropriate provision. When there are more applications for places than there are places available, priority will be given in the following order:

- i. Children in public care or previously in public care but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, child arrangement order or special guardianship order.
- ii. Children who live in the linked area (Boughton) and have an older brother or sister continuing at the school at the time of admission of the younger child.
- iii. Children of staff where that member of staff has been employed at the school for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made, and/or the member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage in the area.
- iv. Children who live in the linked area (Boughton)
- v. Children who live outside the linked area and have an older brother or sister who is continuing at the school at the time of admission of the younger child.
- vi. Other children.

If the admission number is exceeded with any of these criterion, priority will be given to those who live closest to the school.

Tiebreaker

The distance used in a tiebreaker for any oversubscribed criterion will be a straight line distance from the address point of the child's home to the address point of the school (priority being given to the children who live closer to the school). Distances will be determined by the local authority measured on a straight line basis using a geographical information system.

Published Admission Number:

This number is 28 children per year group. The school will not admit beyond this number.

Linked area:

This is defined as Boughton.

Appeals:

You have the right to appeal against a decision not to offer your child a place at Boughton Primary School. Requests for appeals should be made in writing or via an e-mail. Details are available on the Northamptonshire County Council website.
