Parking Reminder

Following numerous complaints from local residents, we are again reminding parents about parking when dropping off and picking up.

Out of courtesy and respect to our neighbours, please do not:

- Obstruct or park across driveways
- Use any driveways to pull onto
- Use any driveways to reverse your car
- Not to block the school car park entrance or use it to turn around in.
- Not to use the staff parking at the front or rear of the school.
- To not park on bends
- To refrain from parking or dropping off on Zig Zag lines or by the traffic calming measure.
- To refrain from parking or dropping off on the Double Yellow lines unless you are a Blue Badge Holder.
