

## Northamptonshire Highways

**Works** – Moulton Lane, Boughton (Week day working only)



**Start Date of works** – Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2018

**Completion** – Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2018 (Weather permitting)

**Scheme type** – Ironwork Renewal Post Micro Asphalt

**Traffic management** - Road closure with access to residents at all times.

**Hours of work** – 09:30 – 15:00

**What we are doing/the benefits** – As you're aware the road was recently resurfaced using Micro Asphalt. The next phase in this process is to raise and renew the ironwork as necessary within the surfacing extents using a method known as Paco Patch.

During these works can you please ensure that vehicles are not parked within the vicinity of any existing ironwork. This will allow us to carry out the works more efficiently thus causing minimal disruption to residents.

### Traffic Management

To ensure the health and safety of the workforce and the public the works will be carried out under a road closure. A diversion will be in place at all times as shown on the map below, the red line being the road closure and the blue line, the diversion.

When programming repair works we consider the impact on all road users and plan our works to minimise disruption. We do understand that the closure will be inconvenient but works can only be completed safely and efficiently with this in place. We hope any inconvenience will be tolerated for the duration of the works.

### Information for residents and businesses

**Access:** Access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times, although they will be escorted through the works by the traffic management team.

**Pedestrians:** Access will be maintained at all times with pedestrian marshals on site to assist residents

**Cyclists:** Access will be maintained
