Background information

- How big is your country?
- What does the country's flag look like?
- What is the name of the language spoken? Can you find a sample of writing or the alphabet?
- What is the money called, and what does it look like?
- Is it a rich or a poor country?
- Does the country have a King or Queen?
- What is the time difference?

Weather

- Is it hot or cold? Does it have a lot or a little rain?
- Does it have earthquakes, hurricanes, tidal waves, volcanic eruptions, tornados etc?

People

- What is the population, how many people live there?
- Do the children go to school? What is the school like? What do they learn at school? Compare their schools to our schools.
- What religion do people follow?
- What traditions do the people keep? (dress, music, dance etc.)

Animals and plant life

- What animals and plant life are found there? Can these animals/plants be found in the wild in Britain? If not, why not?

Tourism

- Do people go on holiday to your country? If they do, what kind of things do they go to see while they are there?

Olympics/Sport

- Has your country ever held the Olympic Games or other sports tournament? Where was it held? Who won the Olympics?
- Have they taken part in the Olympic games?
