School Uniform

Now that we are back to school fully please can we remind parents of our everyday school uniform policy.

PE kit is to be worn only on your child's dedicated PE day, hoodies are only to be worn on this day they are not part of the everyday school uniform.

WINTER;- Girls = Royal Blue polo shirt*, jade green cardigan/sweatshirt*, grey skirt/pinafore or grey tailored uniform trousers, grey/white socks/tights, black shoes with flat heels (preferably with a strap)

Boys = Royal Blue polo shirt*, jade green sweatshirt*, grey trousers/shorts, grey socks, black shoes.

P.E. KIT = Pale Blue polo shirt*, navy shorts, trainers or black plimsolls. For outdoor PE in the winter, navy jogging bottoms can be worn. A Boughton hoodie is available to purchase via the school office or BSA.

Birthday Gifts/Sweets

Due to Covid we have had to change how we allow items to enter the building. We realise that some children still want to celebrate their birthdays with their classmates and bring in sweets etc.

In order for this to happen in a Covid friendly way we will need to adhere to the following:-

- Items need to be individually wrapped or sealed (e.g. individual cakes/cookies/bags of sweets)
- They need to be delivered to the school office and won't be distributed until 24 hours later so might not be given out on the actual birthday
- A teacher/TA will distribute rather than the children putting hands in a bag and pulling an item out



Fruit/Veg Break

As a school Boughton promotes healthy snacking so we ask that you only send your child in with a piece of fruit or veg for their mid-morning break time.

We also ask that no hot drinks are brought into school. Children are allowed to bring an extra drink in for their lunch however, this must be non-fizzy.



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
