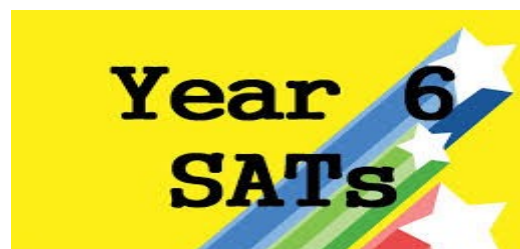

We wish our Year 6 pupils every success.



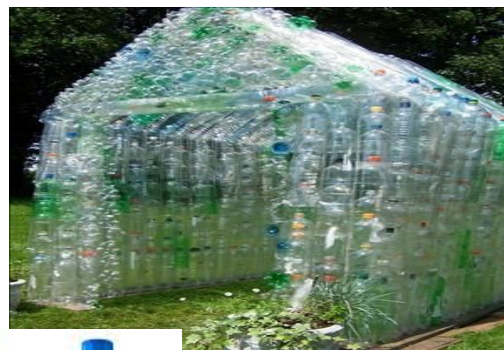
## BSA Afternoon Tea Relaunch
