1. Improve the school infrastructure

Create a priority list and financial capacity to complete agreed refurbishments

Engage the school community in the refurbishment project

2. Prepare for excellence

Support and challenge the leadership team to create a sustainable, high-quality curriculum Provide challenge through audit and observation practices to the wider teams

Ensure resources are in place to allow for excellence in the classroom

Improve communication links between the board, the BSA and the school community

Take an active role in student voice surveys

3. Staff wellbeing and staff engagement

Provide a regular space for staff voice

Ensure staffing ratios allow for development and planning time for all staff

Lead on the staff voice survey

Hold the leadership team to account regarding staff wellbeing levels, turnover and absence rates

4. Student recruitment

Source, design and develop a new website and school app function

Develop and support a three point marketing action plan

Support the leadership team in developing strategic partnerships with local nurseries and pre schools

Support and promote events held by the school

Create a governor link between the board and the BSA to improve collaboration
